

Westerner Park is among Red Deer's premiere venues, annually hosting more than 1.5 million visitors attending over 1,500 unique events. The 320-acre property is Central Alberta's largest convention, trade show, agriculture, entertainment and sports complex.

The newly opened, 51,500-sq.-ft. Exhibition Hall is Westerner Park's largest and most technical venue. Sporting perfect acoustics, soaring windows and stateof-the-art LED lighting, this flexible venue connects to the majority of Westerner Park facilities and is perfect for trade shows, conferences and other large gatherings.

Red Deer is great; it's a smaller community that's easy to get around. This year, for the first time, we used Westerner Park for our two-day trade show. I can't say enough about the property. It's in a great location and the park has several different spaces for whatever your needs may be. We used the new Exhibition Hall and Stockmens Pavilion for our trade show because we needed a space large enough for 130 booths plus 30 fire trucks, aerials and pumpers.



Q+A with...

Trent Rix, Director, Ancillary and Sport Services Red Deer College

How did a recent group use your facilities?

In May 2019, we welcomed the Alberta Health and Physical Education Council conference. It was held primarily at the Gary W. Harris Centre and required use of our sport facilities as well as traditional classroom and theatre-style sessions. The nice thing is that the classroom and seminar spaces are adjacent to the sports spaces.

How can the College enhance a meeting's educational program?

We've got experts on staff who can serve as keynote speakers or workshop facilitators, or to integrate teambuilding activities into programs. For example, we just opened our new Alternative Energy Lab, which supports emerging energy technologies. We also operate the Central Alberta Be Fit For Life Centre and within that group are physical literacy experts who can customize different programs for events, such as yoga breaks.

Country Pride Dance Club


